Application Guide

Submit the application in English.

Host

Host first name: The first name of the host.

Please note that the host is also the applicant and must be a research leader or equivalent at a Swedish university. Applications submitted by the postdocs themselves will not be considered.

Host surname: The surname of the host.

Academic title: The academic title of the host.

Department: The name of the host department.

Host university: The name of the host university/institute.

Country: The country where the host university.

Invitation letter: A signed invitation on letterhead in PDF format from the host.

The invitation letter should formally invite the postdoc to the host department and express any expectations regarding the stay.

Postdoc

First name: The postdocs given name that comes before the family name.

Surname: The postdocs last name that they share with other members of their family.

Please do not write names in all-caps.

Gender: The gender of the postdoc.

E-mail: The e-mail address of the postdoc.

Verify E-mail: The e-mail address of the postdoc again.

Home address: The current home address of the postdoc.

Zip code: The postcode of the current home address of the postdoc.

City: The postal locality/city of the current home address of the postdoc.

Citizenship: The citizenship/s of the postdoc.

Current employment: A description of the current employment of the postdoc.

Where the postdoc work, in what position, what the position entails.

Bachelor's and master's degrees

Bachelor's degree obtained: The date when the postdoc obtained a bachelor's degree.

If the postdoc does not have a bachelor's degree, skip this field.

University where degree was awarded: The name of the university where the postdoc obtained a bachelor's degree.

If the postdoc does not have a bachelor's degree, skip this field.

Country where degree was awarded: The country where the postdoc obtained a bachelor's degree.

If the postdoc does not have a bachelor's degree, skip this field.

Master's degree obtained: The date when the postdoc obtained a master's degree.

If the postdoc does not have a master's degree, skip this field.

University where degree was awarded: The name of the university where the postdoc obtained a master's degree.

If the postdoc does not have a master's degree, skip this field.

Country where degree was awarded: The country where the postdoc obtained a master's degree.

If the postdoc does not have a master's degree, skip this field.

Doctoral degree

University where PhD was/will be obtained: The university outside EU/EFTA/UK where a PhD degree was/will be obtained by the postdoc.

Accepted to PhD programme: The date when the postdoc was admitted to the PhD programme at the university named in the previous field.

PhD obtained: The date when the postdoc obtained a PhD.

If the postdoc has yet to obtain a PhD, skip this field.

PhD expected: The date when the postdoc expects to obtain a PhD.

Please note that this date needs to be verified by a statement from the doctoral supervisor later in the application. If the postdoc has already obtained a PhD, skip this field.

Title of doctoral thesis: The title of the postdocs doctoral thesis.

If the postdoc has yet to obtain a PhD, skip this field.

Abstract of doctoral thesis: The abstract of the postdocs doctoral thesis.

If the postdoc has yet to obtain a PhD, skip this field.

Study interruption: State the case if requesting an exemption from the two-year rule (obtaining a PhD no more than two years before the deadline).

Consult the call text for eligible reasons for being granted an exemption. Any requests will be subject to control at STINT's discretion and may need to be substantiated by additional documentation. If the postdoc has no study interruptions, skip this field.

Postdoctoral visit

Planned start date of postdoctoral visit: The date when the postdoctoral visit in Sweden is planned to start.

This date is not binding and only for planning purposes.

Planned length of visit in months: The planned length of the postdoctoral visit in Sweden.

This length is not binding beyond the required 12 months. Please note that submitting a project with a longer duration will not increase the competitiveness.

Accompanying family members: Accompanying family members included in the application for family contributions to the stipend. State their names, the postdocs relationship to them and the age and birth dates of any children.

Postdoctoral project

Project title: The title of the postdoctoral project.

Good titles are not overly long and do not include unnecessary information (e.g., "International collaboration between X and Y in ..."). Use sentence case rather than title case.

Abstract: The abstract of the postdoctoral project.

Project description: The project description of the postdoctoral project as a PDF.

Refer to the call text for requirements.

The maximum length is eight pages in PDF format, using 12pt Times New Roman, 1.15 line spacing, one-inch margins and regular paragraph lengths of about two hundred words. Please do not try to submit more text by using a small font or similar; it will not improve the project description.

Please also note that it is not a good idea to formulate a project description as a Q&A based on the sample questions in the review criteria.

Additional attachments

CV: The CV of the postdoc as a PDF.

Publications: The publication list of the postdoc as a PDF.

If the postdoc has yet to publish anything, upload a placeholder document to this effect.

PhD certificate (or verification of planned completion of PhD by doctoral supervisor): A PDF copy of the postdocs PhD certificate.

Alternatively, upload a signed verification on letterhead confirming that the postdoc will complete a doctoral degree (within a year from the deadline) by the doctoral supervisor.

Formal conditions

I agree to the formal conditions: Read through the formal conditions and confirm whether you agree to them.

Note that the formal conditions of the programme must be accepted for an application to be eligible.
